**GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS**

**Parents are requested to ensure strict compliance by their ward(s) of the guidelines given below in addition to the guidelines issued by the Govt. of Jharkhand, MHA and MoHFW:**

- i. Buses may ply for the students depending upon the Govt. guidelines till then students will make their own arrangements to come to school.
- ii. On arrival, they will wait at the designated circles outside the gate maintaining a distance of minimum 6 feet and co-operate with the checking staff at the gate.
- iii. They will bring the laminated copy of consent form along with their School ID card which will be checked at the entry gate and no child will be allowed to enter the school campus without these.
- iv. The students will carry the following items of good quality with them on every visit to school-
  - a. Masks – 2 Nos. (One on face and one to be carried in the bag)
  - b. Sanitiser bottle (50ml) – 1 No.
  - c. Liquid Soap/Hand wash (100 ml) – 1 No.
  - d. Paper Napkin/Small Towel – 2 Nos.
  - e. Hand gloves – 1 Pair
  - f. Transparent drinking water bottle
- v. They will bring their individual lunch box. Sharing of food items/water/books/copies etc. is strictly prohibited.
- vi. They will not carry any kind of electronic gadgets such as mobiles, Bluetooth devices, earphones etc.
- vii. Gate No. 2 and 3 will be operational for students for entry and exit only. Students coming on bicycle will enter and exit through Gate no. 3 only.
- viii. Students will go to the respective classrooms immediately upon arrival maintaining a distance of 6 feet.
- ix. The students will wash their hands with their own liquid soap/handwash thrice during the school hours- First after reaching school, second during lunch break and third before leaving school.

- x. The students will sit on the designated chair in the classroom only. They will not move the table and chair from the allocated places in the classroom as the sitting arrangement has been made keeping a distance of 6 feet between two consecutive desks and disturbing this arrangement is strictly prohibited.
- xi. At any point of time, not more than three students shall enter the washroom.
- xii. They will not be allowed to roam outside the classroom.
- xiii. They will not litter the trash anywhere except the closed dustbins kept in the classroom.
- xiv. Students having any symptom of cough, cold or fever shall not be sent to school.
- xv. Canteen will not be operational.
- xvi. They should sanitize their hands at regular intervals.
- xvii. At the time of arrival/dispersal, they should walk in a queue maintaining a distance of 6 feet (social distancing) and strictly follow the instructions given by the school staff.
