## **SUMMER VACATION ASSIGNMENTS FOR STUDENTS**

### **Std - 3 to 10 & 12**

**1. Travel Experience:** Students have to write their experience of the places they have visited during summer vacation.

**2. Book Reading & Review:**

- (i) Students will select a book for the reading purpose.
- (ii) Students have to answer 5 questions, given in software based on the book they have selected.
- (iii) Teachers have to make some criteria to select best 3 book reviews and acknowledge them accordingly.

**3. Group Projects:**

- There will be 3 students in each group.
- Students can select any one topic from the list given below and prepare a detailed report for the same.
- The report should contain observations, photographs, evidences, suggestions & corrective measures.
- The topics for the group project are as follows: -
  - (i) Survey of cleanliness of their neighborhood
  - (ii) Working of Post Offices & Banks
  - (iii) Art & Craft (Sketching/analysis of renowned paintings/ best use of waste etc.)
  - (iv) Video on doodle making
  - (v) Film making videos on either of the topics: -
    - Traffic rules
    - Line Sketch of Vidyalaya
    - Road layout of Bokaro
    - Survey of vegetable market
    - Demographic distribution of Bokaro
    - Data Collection about number of hawkers/vegetable vendors coming to sell their products in local residential areas & people buying these products.
    - Seva Project (At home/In neighborhood/ In society)
    - Food habits – Survey of any Dairy/Grocery Store/ Food Mart. Collect data about the sales & consumption of variety of products.
    - Traffic rules- watch and observe number of people following the traffic rules/ how the traffic police controls the traffic etc.

**4. Subject Based Assignments:** To be given by teachers and posted in the school website. Students can download their assignments and complete them.
